A History of **Operation Santa Claus**




In 1957, one of our saints. Martha Cornett, helped initiate Operation Santa Claus with the help of Church Women United. Portsmouth Unit. At that time there was no federal assistance for foster parents. The CWU helped approximately 20 foster parents in 1957.

Almost 60 years later, 59 years to be exact Church Women United is still carrying on that gift of love and tradition; supporting and sponsoring Operation Santa Claus in Portsmouth.

West Side still continues this tradition. This year we had nine children to buy gifts for, to wrap them in colorful paper, and to have them dedicated on December 2. The social service workers receive these gifts and distribute them to foster parents.

In the season of Advent we wait for our Saviors' birth and children wait to see what is under the tree. May God bless you as the season of Advent brings you peace, joy, hope and love.
